Abstract

This is a “sample paper” which gives some additional guidelines for the preparation of papers for cvww02 using L^AT_EX formatting system.

1 Introduction

The paper should consist of a title, author’s name(s) and affiliation, address, e-mail address, abstract, main section, conclusions, references and optional appendices.

2 Main Section

Each paper must start with an abstract, not to exceed 200 words. The paper should not exceed 10 pages, including tables and figures. For text use 12 point Times Roman font. Do not use page numbers.

2.1 Equations

Center the equations and number them on the right margin,

$$x = y. \tag{1}$$

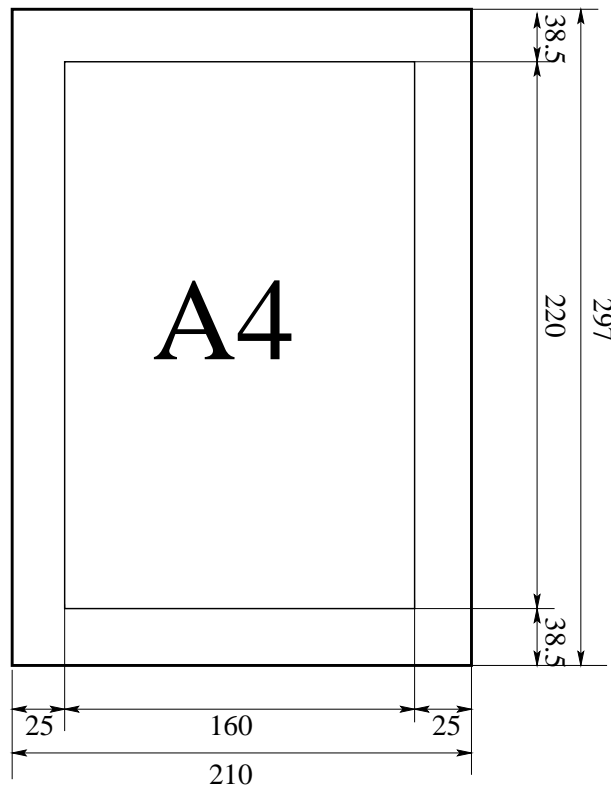


Figure 1: Camera-ready paper geometry. Text should be placed within the given boundaries.

Equations should be referenced by placing the number in parentheses, e.g. Equation (1). Figures should be numbered and inserted in the text, such as Figure 1. Each figure should have a concise caption. References to figures should be as follows: Figure 1, Figures 2a and 3b.

2.2 References

All references cited in the text should be marked by numbers in square brackets, and listed at the end of the paper in alphabetical order under the first author's last name. Complete information should be given for each reference, see [1] or [1, 2].

3 Conclusions

Please send a PDF file (PostScript possible) using anonymous ftp to `ftp.prip.tuwien.ac.at`, directory `/cvww02/incoming/` not later than December 1, 2001.

The name of the file containing your submission must have the following format:

"xxx.ext"

where "xxx" is the first author's last name and "ext" is the extension depending on which file format you use.
